INDICATIONS FOR USE

The NeoSucker is indicated for use as a vacuum powered suction device to aspirate fluids from the mouth and nares.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Step 1

Connect barbed end of NeoSucker to suction line.

Step 2

Set suction to appropriate pressure per hospital protocol or physician recommendation.

Step 3

Block thumb port with thumb to begin suctioning.

Step 4

Suction mouth or nares with intermittent suctioning.

Note: For intermittent suctioning, unblock thumb port to stop suctioning. Block thumb port again to continue suctioning.

Step 5

Suction sterile water through NeoSucker after each use.

Step 6

Replace NeoSucker every 24 hours or per hospital protocol, whichever is sooner.
