

INDICATIONS FOR USE

The NeoSeal is intended to create a seal around the nares and protect the skin of the nasal septum and nares. It is intended for use on pediatric (neonates, infants and children) patients.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1 Peel NeoSeal from plastic liner.
- 2 Slip over nasal prongs with adhesive facing cannula.

Note: Soft, smooth side without adhesive should contact patient's skin.

3 Insert prongs per hospital protocol. Document placement of the NeoSeal in the patient's medical record.

Note: To minimize risk of aspiration/ingestion, ensure the nasal cannula prongs and/or NeoSeal do not enter the infant's mouth.

4 Replace NeoSeal daily or per hospital protocol, whichever is sooner.

Note: Replace immediately if soiled or wet.

5 Document removal and/or replacement in the patient's medical record.
