INDICATIONS FOR USE

The NeoGlo Transilluminator is a hand-held light source intended to transmit light through tissues to aid examination of patients.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1 Remove NeoGlo from packaging. Insert into NeoGlo Sleeve if using.
- 2 Plug USB cord into laptop, portable power bank (not included), or other USB power source. Note: While plugging in, ensure that lights are directed away from all persons' eyes.
- 3 Hold NeoGlo against skin or beneath site to be examined.
Note: Dim room lights for most effective illumination.
Caution: Avoid continuous use over 10 minutes.
- 4 Peel and discard clear, plastic liner from top non-woven tab and apply to skin on opposite side of tubing. Tubing should fit snugly in tubing channel.
- 5 Clean NeoGlo with alcohol wipe or CaviWipe™ after each use.
- 6 Recycle or dispose of NeoGlo in accordance with local and federal regulations.
